Call for Papers

Dear Colleagues,

we have started preparations for the *21. International Congress on Ancient Bronzes*, which will take place in Budapest, Hungary. The Congress is organized by the Department of Classical and Roman Archaeology at ELTE Eötvös Loránd University in cooperation with the Hungarian National Museum.

Although it is difficult to predict the end of the pandemic, we hope that the Congress can be safely held in **April 2022** as an onsite conference here in Budapest.

All submissions on ancient bronzes are welcome, including bronze artefacts from European Iron Age and the Mediterranean region, bronzes from military context, large-scale bronzes, statuettes, toreutics, manufacturing techniques and analytics, restoration, written records or any relevant topics.

Please note that presentations should not exceed 20 minutes. The language of presentation should be English, German or French. All submissions will go through a peer review process. The final conference program will be announced in December 2021.

The conference fee of EUR 100 can be paid via bank transfer. Due to the unpredictable pandemic situation, we prefer to start collecting the registration fee in January 2022. All registered participants will be notified later by email with the details of transferring the fee. The registration fee includes a conference bag, the reception, coffee breaks and the conference dinner.

Submissions can be made online at the website of the conference (bronze2022.elte.hu) until 30 November 2021. After the deadline the registration will remain open only for attendants without presentation.
